## Monuments of Early Renaissance Architecture In the Region Called Lubelszczyzna.

## Summary

A short article (one of the two planned parts describing the Renaissance architecture in the region called Lubelszczyzna) mentiones some characteristic features of buildings in the Renaissance epoch in Lublin province. It describes early signs of Renaissance laying emphasis on their Gothic and Byzantine traditions.

The inhabited tower in Wojciechów and the parish church in Chodel were described as early Renaissance-Gothic monuments. From later period when the style was developing the following monuments were mentioned or described: the castles in Lublin and Janowiec, the town halls in Zamośc and Lublin, the tenements in Lublin and the collegiate in Zamośc (without interior equipment). The article is complemented by illustrations and bibliography.
