SUMMARY

Wincenty Pol in Bieszczady

The article presents Wincenty Pol's relationships with people living in the area of the Sanok land. Among all his relationships with people from Bieszczady, the most important is the one with the family of Krasicki from Lesko, and with Ignacy and Zygmunt Kaczkowski.

The study includes a description of the trip to Łopiennik (1069 meters above sea level), and hunting trips in the forests surrounding Kalnica, a village where Wincenty Pol leased out an estate from Ksawery Krasicki.

His stay in Bieszczady was an inspiration to write Kohort, Rok Myśliwca, Pieśń Janusza and a description of the southern Sanok land.

All geographic, environmental and ethnographic information contained in the works of a poet and a geographer of this region are definitely a valuable source of a tourist knowledge which remains valid in our times.
