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Sleeping on hay – new touristic product of Roztocze

Roztocze is a region, where the unique environmental and cultural values have been preserved.

Additionally, it is a relatively little industrialized and urbanized region, with the predominating function of agriculture. Thus, it creates a perfect condition for the development of different forms of agricultural tourism. One of such forms bases on farm stays (both sleeping and dining).

The article presents ‘sleeping in the hay’ as a developing tourism product in Roztocze. The offer includes accommodation located along the Central Roztocze Blue Trail leading from Szastarka to Bełżec. Tourists will spend the night in a barn atop a pile of hay in assigned single-, double- or multi- person sections. Their number, size and location will depend on the size of the barn. Each assigned section will be provided with fresh hay daily (which is the main condition for enjoyable stay), as well as a shelf for personal belongings, a lamp and a curtain or wooden door. An integrated booking system will be available.
