Prospects for tourism development in Ukrainian Roztocze

The article presents the tourist attractions of Ukrainian Roztocze in the cultural and natural aspect, as well as in terms of the available tourism infrastructure. In the cultural aspect, the numerous orthodox churches are really interesting, both the brick and wooden ones (the most valuable of them can be found in Potylicz). In terms of natural values (the future World Biosphere Reserve), a class in itself are the areas around Ivano-Franków (former Janów), located on the border of the Jaworowski National Park and Roztocze Reserve. Also, a powerful complex of artificial lakes should be mentioned (with the picturesque lake called Janowski Lake) as well as the unique caves in Stradcz and Krechów.

Another type of attractions is the well-known spas in Szkło and Niemirów. And in the context of infrastructure the development of accommodation range should be emphasized, based on the small hotels, as well as the appearance of the first marked hiking trails. This is a significant potential that can be used for tourism development in line with sustainable development principle, i.e. not only providing resources and promoting the region, but also making sure that they are preserved for future generations.
