Regional forms of the religious architecture of the Roztocze

The article is synthesis of characteristic architectural forms performing in the religious building industry in the “Roztocze” region on the Polish and Ukrainian side. The author is discussing the wooden and brick-built architecture in the range of the Catholic Church, of the Orthodox Church and the Greek-Catholic Church, pointing at mutual sources of the inspiration. He is bringing forward for produced in this area and applied extensively characteristic buildings both under consideration of the lump of the building, as well as of architectural detail. They are these are wooden Orthodox Churches covered with three domes about the tricuspid setup, especially, buildings decorated with the characteristic detail among other things in the type of „Renaissance of the Lublin Region”, Churches raised on both sides of the Polish-Ukrainian limit in the last 17th quarter by the Jan Michał Link architect of the Zamoyski Magnate’s estate. Discussing the religious architecture the author is bringing forward too for Jewish temples. The article is complemented by illustrations and bibliography.
